Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the aforesaid representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

From bare perusal of the paper book, it reveals that the dispute is between the petitioner-wife on one side and respondent No.4-husband as well as respondent No.5-mother-in-law on the other side. However, considering the limited prayer of the petitioner for protection of her life and liberty, without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the contents of representation dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) qua the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner only and to act in accordance with law.
