All the contempt petitions bearing COCN Nos. 3095, 3096, 3097, 3098, 3099, 3100, 3101, 3102, 3103 and 2680-2017 shall stands disposed of by this common order in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents before this Court.

It is stated that the LPA has been filed in all the above cases in which notice of motion has been issued for 20.03.2019 by recording the contentions of learned counsel for the respondents that the workmen's own case regarding termination of services but the same was construed it as abandonment of service and unfair trade practice without even advertng to the fact that there was a clear offer made by the management to the workmen to join their duties.

It is further stated on instructions from the respondents that in case the respondents fail to get relief on the said date, the respondents shall immediately reinstate the petitioners and grant all the consequential benefits in terms of the said order within two weeks from 20.03.2019.

In view of the same, all the present contempt petitions are disposed of in the above terms with liberty to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petitions in case the respondents do not honour the statement made before this Court in the eventuality of their getting no relief.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
