Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty and also seeks issuance of a direction so as to get the matter pertaining to FIR No. 126, dated 23.3.2018, registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat, under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, investigated fairly and properly.

Learned counsel has submitted that the petitioner was shot at while he was going home after closing his shop regarding which FIR No. 126, dated 23.3.2018, was registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat, for offences under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act. Learned counsel has further submitted that in the year 2005, petitioner's brother Robin Bareja as well as his friend Honey son of Madan Lal were shot at resulting in injuries to both the persons and wherein subsequently Honey son of Madan Lal expired regarding which FIR was

lodged at the instance of petitioner's brother Robin Bareja. It has further been submitted that while the petitioner and his brother were present in the Court in connection with the said case, the private respondents issued threats while stating that Robin Bareja has been taking care of and the petitioner would also be taught a lesson.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sonapat (respondent No.2) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation dated 11.4.2018 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously. In case the allegations leveled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon in accordance with law. Further, in case there is any imminent threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, then it be ensured that no harm is caused to the petitioner. It is further directed that the matter pertaining to FIR No. 126, dated 23.3.2018, registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat, under Sections 307/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act be investigated expeditiously and fairly and a final report be submitted therein at the earliest.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-6 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sonapat (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do the needful.
