The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.05.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 13572 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondents to look into the grievance unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 23.03.2018 (P-8) and take a conscious decision, in the light of the service Rules and Instructions issued by the Government dated March 14, 2017 (P-2), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, in case, petitioners still feel aggrieved of the order passed by concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under law including to approach this Court.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Ajoy Sharma, IAS, Chief Executive Officer, PWSSB, along with order dated 17.05.2019 filed in Court are taken on record. A copy of the same are handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Rs. 2,000/- , in cash as costs, is handed over to the petitioner.

This Court while disposing writ petition, itself, granted liberty to have recourse to remedies available under law including to approach this court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition to avail the remedies in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. Rule issued against respondents is discharged.
