This order will dispose of two contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.3156 of 2018 and 3202 of 2018, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

Sh. Nikhil Gajraj, IAS, Director, Consolidation of Holdings, Haryana is present in Court and has filed affidavit dated 18.4.2019 stating therein that the order has been complied with. The petitioners have already been reinstated back in service w.e.f. 7.9.2018. Arrears for the period from 7.9.2018 to 3.2.2019 have also been released to the petitioners. The details of the amount so released have been separately placed on record. It is further stated that reply filed in COCP No. 3156 of 2018 be read as reply in COCP No.3202 of 2018.
