Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the review filed by the respondents was dismissed on 15.7.2019 and an undertaking was given by the Director, Department of Health Family and Welfare, Punjab, that arrears would be disbursed within six weeks.

Learned counsel for the respondents has produced office order dated 30.9.2019 wherein the amount of ₹20,58,315/- has been sanctioned. She on instructions from Mr. Vikram Batish, Senior Assistant O/o DHS Punjab, states that the payment would be made within four weeks from today.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.

The respondents shall also provide the detailed calculation of amount found due. In case there is any grievance of the petitioner with regard to calculation, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law. In case the statement made today is not adhered to, the

petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting officer/official.
