The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the orders dated 19.11.2013 and 04.09.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No. 24807 of 2013.

The reply filed by respondents stating that petitioner No.1 was relieved from service on 21.05.2013 and his dues up to that date have already been cleared. So far as the petitioner No.2 is concerned, he was relieved from service on 19.11.2013 and his dues up to that date have also been cleared.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has not disputed the afore-said

fact.

In view of the above, the order of this Court has been complied with, no further order is required to be passed in contempt petition.

Dismissed as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondents is hereby discharged.

However, it is clarified that if any grievance survives, petitioner No.1 would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.
