The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 22.2.2017, vide which, the claim of the petitioner was ordered to be decided in the light of the judgment in CWP No.13630 of 2012 titled as Chander Bhan Sharma vs. Haryana Urban Development Authority and others, decided on 10.10.2012.

Short affidavit of Deepak Ghanghas, Estate Officer, HSVP, Rewari dated nil filed in Court is taken on record. As per the reply, the order has been complied with by way of passing a speaking order dated 11.7.2018 (Annexure R-1), vide which the petitioner has been held to be eligible for allotment of Plot No.509, Sector-18 (Defence), Rewari, subject to his submitting the documents.
