AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that benefits of deemed regularization have been granted to the petitioner alongwith interest. Though, a payment of ₹12,000/- odd towards interest is pending, same shall be paid within ten days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that arrears and salary have not been paid. The said contention is contested by the respondents stating that directions of this Court was to grant deemed date of regularization, as such no arrears of salary are due.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law including moving an application for

clarification in the order of writ petition.

In view of above, contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
