The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 08.03.2017 vide which the writ petition was allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file representation before the respondents considering 15 years service had rendered by him in the department for the purposes of compulsory retirement.

Reply is already on record. As per the said reply, the case of the petitioner was rejected by passing of a speaking order dated 29.06.2017 (Annexure-5/T).

Admittedly, the petitioner has since died on 22.11.2018.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

In case, the petitioner is still aggrieved by passing of speaking order, he is at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law.
