The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.98 dated 22.6.2018, registered at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 379-B, 427, 506, IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 24.10.2018. The investigation is complete, but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 02 PWs have been examined till date out of total of 30 PWs. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents. Even in this case, he is not accused of physically snatching the money alleged snatched from the complainant. Thus, he may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 18.2.2019, by way of affidavit of Sh. Rajender Singh, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Yamuna Nagar, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 22 days and there are no other criminal case pending or decided against him.

The factual submissions made by counsel for the petitioner

have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Ramesh Kumar @ Titu, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
