The present contempt petition is filed for violation of the order dated 24.10.2013.

Admittedly, the writ petition in which the stay was passed has since been dismissed and there is no observation with respect to any violation of the present order.

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner took time to go through the affidavit dated 27.2.2019 filed by respondents No.1 to 16 stating therein that the Committee had taken the possession way back on 25.7.2010. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner while arguing submitted that as per the reply filed earlier, the same respondents had given

ejectment and in the same written statement, it is submitted that the possession was never with the petitioner.

Heard. The writ petition having been dismissed way back, this Court does not find the facts of the present case fit enough to continue with the present contempt petition. The same is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) stands discharged.
