The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 25.05.2018 vide which a direction was issued to decide the representation dated 22.04.2018 and to take appropriate action as warranted under law.

Reply has been filed stating therein that the matter has been considered and inquired into and after inquiry it was found that the Revenue Department had made wrong entry with regard to Khasra No. 118//22(2-14) and now the rectification has already been made.

On last date of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner took time to verify the same. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that on verification he has come to know that the petitioner had never mentioned about Khasra No. 118//22(2-14), whereas the respondents have changed the entry with respect to the said Khasra No.118//22(2-14). However, a perusal of the representation shows that there is no mention of any Khasra No. at all, leave alone Khasra No. 118//22(2-14).

Hence, no contempt is made out. Otherwise also, it appears to be a

case of Civil dispute for which the petitioner has already availed the remedy.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
