Learned counsel for the respondents states that the entire exercise is complete and the seniority list of all eligible candidates stands prepared and shall be uploaded within ten days from today and, thereafter the eligible candidates will be considered for promotion within next four weeks thereafter.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is disposed of with a direction that the needful be done within the stipulated period. In case, the needful is not done within the stipulated period, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition again. In case the petitioner is forced to revive the contempt petition, heavy penalty shall be imposed upon the respondents.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
