In pursuance to the order dated 3.4.2019 passed by this Court, affidavit of Arun Kumar Gupta, Principal Secretary Home, Chandigarh Administration dated 29.4.2019 has been filed. As per para 3 of the same, the posts of Reader Grade-I, Bailiff, Process Server and Daftris/Ushers are entitled for the pay scales revised by the Chandigarh Administration vide letter dated 14.2.2012 since they were equated by the Shetty Commission. Consequently, it has been decided in the meeting convened on 15.4.2019 under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary Home, Chandigarh Administration that the file may be sent to the Finance Department, Accounts Branch, Chandigarh. After receiving the requisite approval, it was decided that the Chandigarh Administration would grant the revised pay scales as recommended by the Shetty Commission and also in compliance of the order dated 16.3.2015 passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in WP (C) 1022 of 1989. Communication to the said effect has also been sent by the Chandigarh Administration to the Registrar General, Punjab and Haryana

Administration to grant pay scale as recommended by the Shetty Commission. The said letter has also been placed on record as Annexure R-1.

It is further submitted by Mr. Pankaj Jain, Sr. Standing Counsel, UT, Chandigarh that the same shall be applicable from the date when the same was granted to the employees of the Chandigarh Administration in order to maintain parity.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stand discharged.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to revive the present contempt petition in case of any further grievances.
