The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 22.11.2017, vide which, a direction was issued to decide the representation/legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Neeru Garg, Block Development and Panchayat Officer filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the order has been complied with and the legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by way of passing a speaking order dated 25.04.2018, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that certain averments in the legal notice have not been dealt with in the speaking order. However, a perusal of the legal notice shows that there is a vague reference of the enquiry. No date of the enquiry, as to who conducted the enquiry or the report in itself is neither on record and nor is stated to have been either attached in the writ petition or given to the respondents. Hence, no further order is required to be passed in the present contempt petition.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file fresh detailed representation to the respondents, which shall be decided by the respondents, in accordance with law.
