The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0096 dated 16.6.2017 registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani under Sections 34, 447 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.1.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Loharu has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Rameshwar, Pradeep,

Karni and Laxminarain and also of complainant Barmanand have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves and they have no objection in case the FIR is quashed.

The learned Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Loharu has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0096 dated 16.6.2017 registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani under Sections 34, 447 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
