The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 07.09.2017 passed by this Court in COCP No. 2528 of 2017. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“Neither any representation has been placed on record by learned counsel for the petitioner nor any direction has been issued by this Court vide order dated 14.7.2017 to take action on the representation. No case is made out for attracting the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act. However, the petitioner is at liberty to move detailed representation to the competent authority i.e. Superintendent of Police, Ambala within a period of four weeks from today. In case such representation is moved by the petitioner within the stipulated period, the respondent is directed to take action thereupon in accordance with law within a period of one month thereafter.”

Respondents have filed the reply. Along-with the reply an inquiry report dated 04.01.2018 has been annexed.

Learned State counsel states that the order of this Court has been complied with and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the inquiry has not been conducted properly and petitioner is aggrieved of the inquiry report.

In view of the above, the order of this Court has been complied with, no further order is required to be passed in contempt petition.

Disposed of, as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondent is hereby discharged.

However, it is clarified that still if any grievance survives with regard to the inquiry report, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies as are available in accordance with law.
