The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 14.11.2017, vide which, a direction was issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Sonapat to verify the documents of the petitioner and hear him in person and determine his claim with respect to allotment of a 100 square yard plot.

Reply on behalf of the respondent is already on record. As per the said reply, the case of the petitioner was considered as per the directions of this Court and a speaking order dated 24.12.2018 was passed, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1 but rejected the same on the ground that he was not eligible for allotment of plot as he was working on the post of Hawaldar from 30.06.1975 to 27.04.2011.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

The petitioner is at liberty to challenge the said speaking order dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure R-1), in accordance with law, if so aggrieved.
