This order shall dispose of twenty five contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.438 to 440 of 2019, 3278 of 2018, 3279 to 3280 of 2018, 3291 of 2018, 3292 of 2018, 3300 of 2018, 3333 of 2018, 3425 of 2018, 3430 of 2018, 3431 of 2018, 3409 of 2018, 3514 of 2018, 3515 of 2018, 3564 to 3566 of 2018, 3648 of 2018, 3649 of 2018 and 3718 to 3721 of 2018 as common question of law and facts are involved therein.

The present contempt petitions are filed for non-compliance of the order dated 27.3.2018 vide which the respondents have been directed to treat the petitioner (s) at par with the petitioner(s) in the case of **Chiman Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation and others** decided on 29.2.2016 and consider their claim in the light of the said case and pass the consequential order within three months from the date of receipt of a

Certified copy of that order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has placed on record the order dated 29.11.2018 passed in LPA No.-1849-2018 in which the Division Bench was pleased to stay the effect and operation of the said judgment passed by the learned Single Judge.

In view of the same, no contempt can be said to be made out.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

However, the petitioner(s) is at liberty to file a fresh contempt petition in case the LPA is dismissed.
