The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 31.10.2017, vide which, direction was issued to decide the legal notice of the petitioner.

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the order has been complied with. The petitioner himself vide Annexure R2/A had requested to the Deputy Conservatory of Forests, Rohtak that the payment of gratuity out of 10 months salary (leave encashment) and gratuity may be paid to him and withhold his 10 months salary (leave encashment) during the pendency of the enquiry and the respondents have accordingly vide order dated 5.4.2018 after deducting the amount towards the shortage of trees, a sum of ₹1,94,240/- has been paid

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stand discharged.

However, if the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to challenge the same as per the direction already given by the Writ Court in accordance with law.
