The present contempt petition was filed for non-compliance of order dated 21.04.2018 vide which a direction was issued to decide the legal notice dated 04.12.2017 and in case the said claim is found to be admissible the consequential relief shall also be granted.

Reply on behalf of the respondent has been filed. As per the said reply, the claim of the petitioner is partly accepted. It is further stated that the amount due to the petitioner, in terms of speaking order, shall be paid to the petitioner within four weeks.
