The present contempt petition has been filed alleging the wilful disobedience of the order dated 25.07.2017 passed by this court in CWP No. 19997 of 2009. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“ Considering the aforesaid factual matrix, in our opinion, issues raised by the petitioners regarding release of their land from acquisition on various grounds including the ground of discrimination and the land being not required for widening of road or maintaining green belt deserves to be re-considered by the competent authority in the State.

Let that exercise be carried out within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order. As the petitioners are in possession of the land, which was permitted to continue in possession during the pendency of the writ petitions. Till the matter is finally decided by the competent authority, the interim stay granted by this Court will remain in force.

The writ petitions are disposed of accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the order of this Court has been complied with, as the order dated 18.02.2019 has been passed.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

The petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law, to challenge the order dated 18.02.2019.
