**COCN-33-2018**

This order shall dispose of two contempt petitions bearing COCN Nos.33 and 171 of 2018 as common question of law and facts are involved therein.

In compliance to the last order of this Court, the Director, State Transport, Haryana is present in Court. It is stated that the costs has already been paid.

Both the contempt petitions are filed for non-compliance of order dated 15.05.2017, vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to give pay scales benefits to the petitioners.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Ram Kumar, General Manager, Haryana Roadways filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioners. As per the said reply, the order has

been complied with and after fixation of the pay, arrears of pay and allowances with interest due to the petitioners have been credited through ECS in the account of the petitioners.

In view of the same, no useful purpose would be served in continuing with the contempt petitions. Accordingly, the same are dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case there is any discrepancy in the said amount paid by the respondents, the petitioners are at liberty to file representation to the respondents within one month from the receipt of certified copy of this order, which shall be decided by the respondents within one month from the receipt of the said representation, in accordance with law.
