The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 20.2.2017 vide which a direction was issued that the benefits granted to the petitioner will not be withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record the order dated 31.8.2018 vide which the pay of the petitioner has been refixed. The detail as to how the same has been refixed has also been mentioned in the said order.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, there is any discrepancy or there is any error found in the said calculation, the petitioner is at liberty to file the representation alongwith the calculation as per the petitioner within two weeks from today which shall be considered by the respondent in accordance with law. In case, there is any discrepancy is found in the said amount, the same too shall be paid to the petitioner within one month of the representation otherwise speaking order shall be passed.
