Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents i.e. respondents No.4 to 6.

The petitioner was statedly married with respondent No.4- Devender on 28.11.2011 and there are differences between the couple.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner apprehends threat to her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents, for which, she has submitted a representation (undated) (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion only to respondents No.1 to 3 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case and confining the prayer of the petitioner to protect her life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Rewari to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to take necessary action as regards protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner in accordance with law.
