This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 3.11.2014 passed in CWP No. 18673 of 2012 and other connected matter.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Petitions are, therefore, accepted and the petitioners are held entitled to the benefit of period of service benefits rendered w.e.f date of their first appointment in the year 1994 which was followed by regularization in the year 1997. All the petitioners shall be held entitled to similar benefits for the purposes of reckoning seniority and other related benefits in terms of ACP etc."

The State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Balvir Singh, District Education Officer (S.E.), Hoshiarpur, dated 19.8.2019. Along with reply an order dated 14.3.2017 and compliance report dated 8.7.2019 have been filed. Copy of the reply has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is submitted that State preferred LPA and the order of the learned Single Judge dated 3.11.2014 was modified vide order dated

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is grievance with regard to the order dated 14.3.2017 passed by the respondents and seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the reply filed, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
