Learned State counsel Mr. Ripu Daman, AAG, Haryana assisted by ASI Anil Kumar, Police Station Civil Lines Bhiwani files status report by way of affidavit of Inspector Vidyanand, SHO, Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani, which is taken on record.

Status report perused.

In the light of the report made by way of duly sworn affidavit and as is stated before this Court by the learned State counsel on instructions from the police official present today in the Court, Shanti Devi wife of Ram Kumar has died on 5.1.2019 and her last rites are to be performed on 17.1.2019 coupled with the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner Khanni @ Hansraj happens to be the son of the deceased and his presence at the time of last rites is very much essential as per the rituals and customs prevalent in the society.

In the light of the same and in the interest of justice, the present application stands allowed. The petitioner is allowed *interim* bail for one week commencing from 16.01.2019 subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- with two sureties in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhiwani.

The petitioner shall surrender in the jail on 23.01.2019 at 10.00 a.m.
