This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 4.4.2016 whereby the direction were issued that the representation dated 12.8.2015 of the petitioner shall be decided within three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

On 11.4.2019, Rs.5000/- costs were imposed, while granting time to the respondent to file compliance report. Costs has been paid in Court today by way of demand draft which is handed over to counsel for petitioner.

Compliance report by way of affidavit filed today in Court. Copy handed over to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of compliance report filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the decision.
