The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 8.5.2012.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Jagmohan Singh Mann, Chief Engineer/Canals, Water Resources Department Punjab dated 29.5.2019 filed in Court is taken on record.

It is not disputed that in pursuance to the last order passed by this Court, the petitioner was heard and consequently dispute has been settled, which is also evident from para Nos.6 and 7 of the reply filed by the respondents. The substantial amount due to the petitioner has been paid, which is mentioned in para 7 of the reply, whereas, the amount of 3,18,199/- is still pending as mentioned in para No.6 of the reply. It is further stated that the said amount shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of two months.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, in case, the said amount is not paid within the stipulated period as mentioned above, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the present contempt petition. Further, in case, the said affidavit is found to be incorrect, the petitioner still will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition. As the present contempt petition has been dismissed, the accompanying applications have become rendered infructuous and the same are disposed of as such.
