The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.08.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 3424 of 1994 . The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“ Accordingly, so far as the admitted benefits are concerned, the petitions are allowed. Those benefits be calculated and paid to the petitioners as is the rightful due. However, so far as other issues are concerned, the petitions are dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the 1995 Rules in accordance with law before the appropriate Bench. The benefits under this order as admitted by the State in its written statement be computed and paid within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. ”

In pursuance of order dated 22.08.2016 of this Court, respondents have filed compliance reports dated 18.02.2019 and 01.07.2019 along-with orders dated 16.11.2018, 07.02.2019 and 20.06.2019 passed in compliance of

the order passed of this Court.

Learned State counsel states that the order of this Court has been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioners state that though the orders dated 16.11.2018, 07.02.2019 and 20.06.2019 have been passed but the details of calculations have not been provided. He further states that petitioners are aggrieved of the order(s) passed by the authorities.

At this stage, learned State counsel states that if the petitioners approach the authorities, details of calculation would be provided.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondent is hereby discharged.

However, it is clarified that in case petitioners approach the authorities for details of calculations, the same would be provided within two weeks thereafter.

Petitioners would also be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law in case there is any grievance against the orders passed by the authorities.
