The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 19.07.2018, vide which, direction was issued to the respondents to consider and decide the grievance of the petitioner as contained in the instant petition by passing a speaking order.

Mr. Kuldeep Sheoran, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.2 filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, the case of the petitioner has been considered by way of passing a speaking order 26.12.2018, directing the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Tosham to decide the cases within a period of six months.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case, the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Tosham does not decide the case of the petitioner, he is at liberty to file fresh contempt petition.
