Learned State counsel placed reliance upon the pleadings in the affidavit of Mr. Ajay Singh Tomer, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri and submits that an order dated 13.11.2018 was passed in compliance of the directions of this Court dated 06.07.2018. He undertakes that the copy of the said order would be supplied to the petitioner within 2 weeks, even if already supplied. He submits that on the basis of demarcation done on 20.06.2017 to 24.06.2017, thirty six persons were found to be in illegal possession over 56 sites. He further submits that eviction applications under Section 7-A of the Punjab Village Common Land Regulation Act, 1961 against all the 36 encroachers have been filed and action in accordance with law would be taken against the encroachers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of reply filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. He seeks

liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for the redressal of grievance, if still survives.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
