Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Rajender Goyal, Law Officer, Department of Higher Education Punjab states that grievance of the petitioner raised in the writ petition has been looked into and it has been found that approximately Rs.1.5 crores are due and same would be paid within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if some grievance still survives.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

However, it is made clear that in case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case, the petitioner is forced to do so, exemplary costs shall be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting officer/official personally.
