The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him in FIR No.185 dated 13.11.2018 at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur under Sections 458, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Rajiv Kumar wherein it has been stated that on 10.11.2018, Kulwinder Singh, Yadwinder Singh @ Yadi, Happy and Gurjeet Singh came to his house after scaling the walls of his house and started knocking the door of his room and when the complainant opened the door, he saw Kulwinder Singh and Happy were armed with sticks and they pushed the complainant and were asking the whereabouts of Ramrattan, brother of the complainant. Kulwinder Singh is alleged to have given a stick blow on the wrist of the left hand of the complainant. Gurjeet Singh and Yadwinder @ Yadi are stated to have given blows on left side of the nose and lips of the complainant. When

complainant raised alarm, the relatives of the complainant woke up and thereafter, all the accused ran away from the spot.

Pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation as has been informed by the learned State counsel upon instructions from Satnam Singh, SI.

A perusal of MLR shows that the complainant has sustained simple injuries out of which some are described as “swelling” only.

Having regard to facts and circumstances of the case, especially the nature of injuries sustained by complainant and also that the petitioner has joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 11.01.2019 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
