The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 21.7.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to hand over physical possession of Plot No. 575, sector 8, Phase IV, IMT Manesar measuring 1012.50 sq. meters.

Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record the order dated 16.1.2018 vide which the allotment was made in favour of the petitioner with the further direction to take over the possession. The petitioner is stated to have challenged the same in CWP No. 22930 of 2018.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.
