The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 17.1.2018.

Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record communication dated 28.1.2019, wherein it is stated that the case of the petitioner was examined by the Department regarding the pay protection and the same is protected after the approval from the Finance Department, Haryana.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that after the pay protection the consequential benefits of ACP etc. have not been granted. If it is so, the petitioner is at liberty to file representation claiming the same and thereafter, the respondent shall consider the representation

within one month from the receipt of the same by way of passing a speaking order. In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled, the amount on account of consequential benefits too shall be disbursed to him in pursuance to the order of pay protection.
