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It is not disputed that the order has been complied with by refixation of the pension and the amount has been paid accordingly. However, learned counsel for the petitioners is aggrieved that while doing so, recoveries have been made, which they could not have done.

Admittedly, the question of recoveries was not before the Court deciding CWP No.16932 of 2013.

In view of the order having been complied with, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to challenge the alleged recovery, in accordance with law.
