Vide order dated 17.07.2019, Chairman Zonal-cum-Administrator HUDA-cum-Additional Director Urban Estate, Faridabad was ordered to remain present in Court. It has been informed that she is blessed with a baby recently and is not in a position to travel. However, Mr. Vikash Dhandha, Estate Officer, Faridabad is present in Court today.

Learned counsel for respondents No. 1, 2, 6 to 8, on instructions from Estate Officer, Faridabad, submits that the directions issued by this Court has been complied with.

So far as the contempt petition is concerned, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already challenged the order dated 11.01.2018 by filing a writ petition. He further submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

The present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Vide order dated 17.07.2019, it was noted that it took almost 2 ½ years for the respondent-department to comply with the time bound direction issued by this Court. Estate officer, who is present in Court, states that a three members committee has been constituted to conduct inquiry and appropriate action would be taken on the defaulting officials.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the compliance report of action taken be filed in Court.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
