The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 30.10.2017, vide which, a direction was issued to respondent No.2-Director Elementary Education Haryana to take a conscious decision, in accordance with law on the representation of the petitioner seeking medical reimbursement.

Learned State counsel has placed on record order dated 19.04.2019, vide which, the medical expenses amounting to ₹3,36,447/- have been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner towards medical reimbursement.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, it is not clear as to how the entire amount as claimed by the petitioner has not been paid. Accordingly, the respondent is directed to pass a speaking order qua the same within one month from today to

enable the petitioner to challenge the same, in accordance with law. In case the petitioner is forced to revive the present contempt petition, the responsibility will be of the respondent.
