The present contempt petition is filed for violation of the order dated 27.9.2017 which was passed in terms of the judgment rendered in Savneet Kaur Vs. State of Punjab and others and other connected matters vide which a direction was issued to ensure that the objections filed be referred to independent expert and after the report of the expert/s and their recommendations regarding remedial action to be taken and final result be declared only thereafter.

On the last date of hearing, this Court directed learned counsel for the respondent to place on record the report with respect to question No. 12, if any.

Short reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the question No. 12 of question booklet series 4 (Paper-II) was already placed before the expert body. The report has been placed on record as Annexure R-1.

In view of the same, this Court does not find any violation of the order and the contempt petition is dismissed.
