The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 18.8.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 18364 of 2017. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Be that as it may, believing the statement made by counsel for the petitioner that the revision petition dated 4.8.2017 was filed which was not accepted by the office of the Superintending Canal Officer, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Superintending Canal Officer, Siwani and Water Services Circle, Bhiwani to entertain the revision petition filed by the petitioner, which is attached as Annexure P-7 with this petition and decide the same in accordance with law.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply on behalf of the respondent was filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as the revision has been decided on merits by the respondent, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law against the order passed in the revision.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
