The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 11.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 16668 of 2018.

The relevant portion of the order is quoted below:-

“Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Patiala or any other competent officer(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice (P-7) and to decide the same in accordance with law, rules and instructions, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed an affidavit of Er.

Rajiv Samra, on behalf of the respondent annexing the order dated 28.11.2018.

The said affidavit is taken on record and copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

In view of affidavit filed, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the benefits accrued to the petitioner have been released.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to controvert the afore-said fact.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in the present petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
