Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.113, dated 18.07.2017 for the offences punishable under Sections 307/323/324/452/326/148/149 IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 05.08.2017. However, now at the stage of arguments, the prosecution has moved an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C for summoning the additional co-accused. Therefore, trial is not likely to be concluded at some early date.

On the other hand, learned State counsel does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of

bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
