Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.681 dated 12.10.2018, under Sections 324 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 11.01.2019:-

“Contends that petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail by learned trial Court vide order dated 07.11.2018 and now the offence under Section 307 IPC has been added.

Notice of motion for 08.02.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court and in case he moves an application for bail, he be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions

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as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from HC Sajjan Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 11.01.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
