The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 19.8.2015, vide which, direction was issued to decide the claim of the petitioners as well as other eligible persons of the village and take an appropriate decision qua the entitlement of allotment of plots.

Reply has been filed. As per the reply, out of 18 persons, 8 persons were found to be entitled for the allotment of plots. Copy of the order dated 30.10.2018 is annexed as Annexure R-2/2.

Rejoinder to the reply has been filed in Court, which is taken on record.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to challenge the order 30.10.2018, vide which, claim of some of the petitioners has been rejected, if still aggrieved.
