The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 23.7.2015, vide which interim order of status quo was passed.

While filing the contempt petition, it was alleged that despite the status quo order, the petitioner was transferred from Majitha Division, Amritsar to Drainage Division, Amritsar.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Charanjit Singh, Executive Engineer, Majitha Division, UBDC, Amritsar dated 4.4.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the same, vide order dated 29.8.2017, the Writ Court had directed to the petitioner to get instruction with regard to nearby place, where he can be posted. Thereafter, the main writ petition was disposed of observing that the grievance of the petitioner does not survive as the petitioner was transferred from the office of the Executive Engineer, Majitha Division UBDC, Amritsar to the office of the Executive Engineer, Amritsar Branch Division, Amritsar.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present contempt petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case, any grievance still survives in the present petition, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the same.
