The contempt petition has been filed stating that there was violation of the order dated 16.11.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 26237 of 2017. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“At this stage, we are inclined only to request the respondents to reply to the petitioners' legal notice dated 23.7.2017 (Annexure P-9).

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the respondent states that in compliance of the order dated 16.11.2017 passed by this court, speaking order dated 14.3.2019 has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to dispute the said fact. He states that he may be granted liberty to avail his remedy against the order passed.

In view of the statement made, the Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

Needless to add that the petitioner shall have the liberty to avail his remedy against the order dated 14.3.2019, as available in accordance with law.
