The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 27.2.2017.

Compliance report/reply by way of affidavit of Gulab Singh Gill, Joint Director Horticulture, Punjab dated 27.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the reply, vide speaking order dated 15.2.2019 (Annexure R-2/T), relief claimed by the petitioner has been granted. After carrying out necessary calculation the matter has also been sent to the Accountant General for releasing the payment.

On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Accountant General, Punjab is impleaded as respondent No.2.

Registry is directed to make necessary correction in the memo of parties.

Issue notice of motion to the newly added respondent.

Mr. H.S. Jugait, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice, who prays for time to comply with the order.

In these circumstance, respondent No.2 is directed to do the

needful within four weeks from today.

After doing the needful by respondent No.2, respondent No.1 shall make sure that the amount is deposited in the account of the petitioner within four weeks thereafter.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case the needful is not done, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition and heavy penalty shall be imposed on the respondent-State.
