COCN Nos.3612, 3801, 3781 of 2017 and 180 of 2018 as common question
of law and facts are involved therein.

All the contempt petitions are filed for non-compliance of order
dated 24.05.2017.

Separate reply(s) by way of affidavit of Dr. Jaspal Kaur, Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab, Chandigarh filed in Court in COCPs-3612, 3781 of 2017 and 180 of 2018 are taken on record. As per the said reply(s), the respondents have in due compliance of the order have implemented the said order, subject to the decision of the LPA. The order to the said extent dated 17.12.2018 has also been placed on record. It is further stated that the revised pension cases after inclusion of non-practicing allowance have been approved and sent to the Treasury.

In view of the same, all the contempt petitions are dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
